








FOUR STEPS THE STATE LEGISLATURE CAN TAKE TO GROW WYOMING:

STEP ONE:

Repeal (or fix) Wyoming Constitution Article 16 Section 6



Neither the state nor any county, city, township, town, school district, or any other political subdivision, shall loan or give its credit or make donations to or in aid of any individual, association or corporation, except for **economic** development and necessary support of the poor, nor subscribe to or become the owner of the capital stock of any association or corporation, except that economic development funds, of public employee retirement systems and the permanent funds of the state of Wyoming may be invested in such stock under conditions the legislature prescribes.

STEP TWO: Invest at least 1% of all State savings and investments in Wyoming businesses

Wyoming could also consider participating or matching crowd funding




STEP THREE:

Raise the excise tax rate by one-half percent (0.5%) for economic development

0.5% excise tax in FY2014 would have raised \$113 million for economic development

Failure to take action on health insurance HURTS EVERYONE




