Contracting

Federal government contracts awarded in Wyoming totaled just over **\$281 million** during FY 2015, and of this, **\$54.7 million** was spent with Wyoming small businesses & other entities.

- SBA works with other federal agencies to ensure that small businesses get their fair share of federal contracting dollars
- SBA also works directly with small businesses, provides contracting training, and offers certification & self-certification contracting and business development programs
- The SBA Wyoming District Office has a co-sponsorship agreement in place with the Wyoming Entrepreneur PTAC to offer joint training in Wyoming



Disaster Assistance
